We wish to make two full-time academic appointments to enhance our research strengths in Sleep and Circadian Rhythms and in Toxicology. Both of these are 5\* RAE rated research themes in the Faculty of Health and Medical Sciences and areas of strategic importance to the University. You will be expected to develop an independent research programme to enhance our established teaching and research strengths.

For the Lecturer in Sleep and Circadian Rhythms, experience of conducting sleep studies on human subjects will be an advantage. You will be expected to deliver teaching in Physiology, Pharmacology or Biochemistry to our BSc and MSc programmes.

The Lecturer/Senior Lecturer in Toxicology will have research expertise in toxicology, safety pharmacology, drug metabolism or toxicopathology, in specific areas that complement our existing research activities. Ongoing collaboration with the pharmaceutical industry would be an advantage, reflecting the close links with industry of the toxicology group at Surrey. You will be expected to deliver teaching in toxicology, safety pharmacology, drug metabolism or toxicopathology to our BSc and MSc programmes.

Excellent facilities and support for translational and basic research are available. They consist of the Surrey Clinical Research Centre with 12 fully-equipped bedrooms and experienced clinical and research staff, as well as core facilities for in vivo studies, genetic profiling including microarray, real time PCR, and high throughput genotyping, proteomics and cell culture facilities.

You will report in the first instance to the Head of the Division of Biochemical Sciences (Professor Susanna Hourani) and ultimately to the Dean of Health and Medical Sciences (Professor John Hay).
